### **Decision Record Number 288**

This document records a decision taken by the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner, together with details of the advice he received prior to taking the decision.

### **Decision taken**

The Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner has taken the decision to:

Agree to begin the tender process for maintenance of Station CCTV systems along with Custody CCTV systems and linked control functions with a four-year contract with a total contract value of up to £160,000.00 ex VAT/ £192,000.00 inc VAT. In addition to this, the PFCC has also agreed a short-term extension to the existing contract from 14 May 2022 until 14 August 2022 at a cost of £4954.00 This will ensure a consistent service with the current supplier and allow for good due diligence and a proper procurement process in line with the revised specification.

Professional financial and legal advice has been sought to ensure the decision best supports business need and represents value for money.
